On September 29, TriDelta and Alpha Chi Omega were proud to present speaker Andrea Cooper. Andrea was a TriDelta at Florida State and her daughter, Kristin, was a member of Alpha Chi Omega. Kristin's Story is a mother's tale of her daughter's rape and subsequent suicide. A vibrant 20-year-old Alpha Chi Omega, Kristin, committed suicide

shortly after she was raped by a friend in 1995. Her mother Andrea Cooper made the difficult decision to share her daughter's tragedy with college students all over the nation.

Each year, the Alpha Chi Omega Foundation and the Tri Delta Foundation award twenty grants. Each grant pays all expenses for Andrea to present "Kristin's
