UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE SPONSORS RAPE EDUCATION SPEAKER

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.—Alpha Chi Omega and Delta Delta Delta will sponsor the presentation *Kristin's Story: A Story of Acquaintance Rape and Depression* for the University of Tennessee community. *Kristin's Story*, a proactive, co-educational rape education program, will be held on Sept. 29, 2008 at 7 p.m. in the University Center Ballroom at UT.

Kristin Cooper, a Baker University student and member of Alpha Chi Omega, committed suicide on New Year's Eve, 1995. *Kristin's Story* is the story of a young woman's acquaintance rape and subsequent suicide as told by her mother, Andrea Cooper. Andrea, a member of Delta Delta Delta and a graduate of Florida State University, has been sharing *Kristin's Story* with more than 300 campuses and conventions for the past ten years. *Kristin's Story* is funded by a grant from the Alpha Chi Omega Foundation and the Delta Delta Delta Foundation.

Alpha Chi Omega and Delta Delta Delta are excited about the opportunity to present *Kristin's Story* to the UT community in hopes of raising awareness about the unspoken concerns surrounding acquaintance rape, depression and suicide among college students.
